GRESHAM, SMITH AND PARTNERS

*Amendment to Contract for Architectural Services granted via Resolution No. R203-07/08
and previously amended via Resolution No. R156-08/09
MULTI-USE HISTORIC RIVERFRONT WALKING & BICYCLE TRAIL*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma, Alabama (*the "City"*) is the recipient of a Transportation Enhancement Grant [Project No: STPTE-TE08(934)] from the Alabama Department of Transportation for the development of a Multi-use Historic Riverfront Walking and Bicycle Trail (*the "project"*); *and*

WHEREAS, the City of Selma is responsible for the cost of architectural services provided for the project; *and*

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. R203-07/08 the City entered into a contract with Gresham, Smith and Partners to provide architectural services for the project including scope of work and bid specifications for consideration of \$43,500. Said contract was amended via Resolution No. R156-08/09 to increase the contract amount by \$14,353.00 to cover the cost for additions to the scope of work including additional documents for the multi-purpose sidewalk, amphitheater and boardwalk and other necessary additions, thereby increasing the contract amount to ; *and*


WHEREAS, Gresham, Smith and Partners has submitted a request to make an additional amendment in the amount of \$9,060.00 to cover the cost of preparing the Project Manual(s) and the administration of the Bidding process for the referenced project; *and*

WHEREAS, the Office of Planning and Development requests to pay for this increase of \$9,060.00 via the Community Reinvestment Money Market Account.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Selma City Council that: George Evans, in his capacity as Mayor, is hereby authorized to execute an amended contract with Gresham, Smith and to cover the cost of preparing the Project Manual(s) and the administration of the Bidding process for the referenced project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Office of Planning and Development is hereby authorized to pay for the \$9,060.00 increase via the Community Reinvestment Money Market Account.


