

**RESOLUTION

**PAYMENT OF ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR BROAD STREET
IMPROVEMENTS INVOICED BY RAY HOGG, JR.**

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Selma, Alabama has the management and control of the finances of the City of Selma per State law; and

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2009, as a result of an underground sewage and/or storm water drainage problem, a portion of Broad Street caved in and the Selma City Council declared the cave-in as an emergency in an effort for the Mayor to initiate the process of repairing the damage; and

WHEREAS, on January 12, 2010, the Selma City Council approved resolution 136-09/10 for the City to apply for a Community Development Block Grant to address the urgent need to the City' sewage problem on Broad Street in the amount \$56,000.00 in CDBG grant funds with a \$5,600.00 match from the City of Selma; and

WHEREAS, the Grant was approved and received by the City of Selma and Ray Hogg, Jr. with Hogg Engineering Corporation has confirmed and verified that the project is complete and said invoices on behalf of Smitherman Brothers have been paid; and

WHEREAS, the City of Selma is also in receipt of an invoice from Hogg Engineering Corporation for services related to the Broad Street Sewer Cave-in in the amount of Seven thousand nine hundred ninety-three dollars (\$7,993.00); and

WHEREAS, the City of Selma received the Grant funds for the repair of the cave-in on Broad Street, but said funds were limited and/or restricted to the repair of the cave-in and not for payment of engineering services and fees; and

WHEREAS, the Citizens of Selma approved a \$12,000,000 General Obligation Bond for the purpose of, including but not limited to, constructing improvements to the sanitary sewer facilities, streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, engineering fees are an allowable from the General Obligation Bond and can be allocated for payment upon the City council's approval of the same; and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Selma City Council to allow a portion of the General Obligation Bond in the amount of \$7,993.00 to be allocated from the Sanitary Sewer Improvement account (35.6200.514 430-4) for payment to Hogg Engineering Corporation for engineering services rendered for improvements and repair of the Broad Street cave-in.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SELMA, ALABAMA that the City of Selma hereby accepts the recommendation from the Mayor and hereby authorizes the Treasurer to make payment from the General Obligation Bond in the amount of \$7,993.00 to Hogg Engineering Corporation for improvements and repair of the Broad Street cave-in.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT said payment shall be allocated and taken from the sanitary Sewer Improvements account (35.6200.514 430-4)
